## Westminster Larger Catechism

Q175: What is the duty of Christians after they have received the sacrament of the Lord's Supper?

A175: The duty of Christians after they have received the sacrament of the Lord's Supper, is seriously to consider how they have behaved themselves in it, and with that success; if they find quickening and comfort, to bless God for it, beg the continuance of it, watch against relapse, fulfill their vows and encourage themselves to a frequent attendance on that ordinance: but if they find no present benefit, more exactly to review their preparation for and posture at, the sacrament; in both which if they can approve themselves to God and their own consciences, they are to wait for the fruit of it in due time; but if they see that they have failed in either, they are to be humbled, and to attend upon it afterward with more care and diligence.

If your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it is better that you lose one of your members than that your
