Confession of Faith - Westminster Larger Catechism

Q163: What are the parts of a sacrament?

A163: The parts of a sacrament are two: the one, an outward and perceptible sign used according to Christ's own direction; the other, an inward and spiritual grace signified by it.

Q164: How many sacraments has Christ instituted under the New Testament?

A164: Under the New Testament, Christ has instituted in His church only two sacraments, Baptism and the Lord's Supper.
