Q165: What is Baptism?

A165: Baptism is a sacrament of the New Testament, in which Christ has ordained the washing with water in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, to be a sign and seal of ingrafting to Himself, of remission of sins by His blood and regeneration by His Spirit; of adoption and resurrection to everlasting life: and by which the parties baptized are solemnly admitted into the visible church and enter an open and professed engagement to be wholly and only the Lord's.
