# Westminster Larger Catechism

A97: What special use is there of the moral law to the regenerate?

A97: Although they who are regenerate and believe in Christ are delivered from the moral law as a Covenant of Works, so as by it they are neither justified nor condemned: yet, besides the general uses of it common to them with all men, it is of special use to show them how much they are bound to Christ for his fulfilling it, and thereby to provoke them to more thankfulness, and to express the same in their greater are to conform themselves to it as the rule of their obedience.
