Westminster Larger Catechism

Q100:: What special things are we to consider in the Ten Commandments? A100: We are to consider in the Ten Commandments: the preface, the substance of the commandments themselves, and the several reasons attached to some of them to encourage greater enforcement of them.

Q101: What is the preface to the Ten Commandments?

A101: The preface to the Ten Commandments is contained in these words: "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery." With this God makes known His sovereignty, as being Yahweh, the eternal, unchangeable and almighty God; having His existence in and of Himself, and giving existence to all His words and works; and that He is a God in covenant, as with Israel of old, so with all His people; who as He brought them out of their bondage in Egypt, so He delivered us from our spiritual bondage; and that therefore we are bound to take Him for our God alone, and to keep all his commandments.
