Westminster Larger Catechism

Q 178: What is prayer?

A 178: Prayer is an offering up of our desires to God, in the name of Christ, by the help of His Spirit, with confession of our sins, and thankful acknowledgment of his mercies.

Q 179: Are we to pray to God only?

A 179: God only being able to search the heart, hear the requests, pardon the sins, and fulfill the desires of all, and only to be believed in and worshiped with religious worship; prayer, which is a special part of it, is to be made by all to Him alone and none other.


