## Westminster Larger Catechism

Q121: Why is the word “remember” set in the beginning of the Fourth Commandment?

A121: The word “remember” is set in the beginning of the Fourth Commandment, partly because of the great benefit of remembering it, we being thereby helped in our preparation to keep it; and, in keeping it, better at keeping the rest of the commandments and to continue a thankful remembrance of the two great benefits of creation and redemption which contain an abridged picture of religion: and partly because we are ready to forget it, for that there is less light of nature for it and yet it restrains our natural liberty in things at other times lawful; that it comes but once in seven days and many worldly businesses come between and too often take our minds away from thinking of it, either to prepare for it or to sanctify it; and that Satan with his followers try hard to blot out the glory and even the memory of it and to bring in all hostility to religion and lack of respect for it.
