A120: The reasons attached to the Fourth Commandment, the more to enforce it, are taken from the principles of it, God allowing us six days of seven for our own affairs and reserving but one for Himself, in the words "Six days you shall labor and do all your work" from God's establishment of a special ownership in that day with the words, "the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God" from the example of God who "in six days.. made heaven and earth, the sea and all that is in them and rested the seventh day; and from the blessing that God put on the day, not only in sanctifying it to be a holy day for His service but in ordaining it to be a means of blessing to us in our sanctifying it "Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy."
