Confession of Faith - Westminster Larger Catechism

Q196: What does the conclusion of the Lord's Prayer teach us?

A196: The conclusion of the Lord's Prayer (which is, "For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.") teaches us to enforce our petitions with arguments that are to be taken, not from any worthiness in ourselves, or in any other creature, but from God, and with our prayers to join praises, ascribing to God alone eternal sovereignty, omnipotence, and glorious excellence; in regard to which, as He is able and willing to help us, so we by faith are emboldened to plead with Him that he would, and to rely quietly on Him that he will, fulfill our requests. And to testify our desires and assurance, we say, "Amen."

Call to Confession

Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth. This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. 
