*Q112: What is God's will for us in the ninth commandment?*

**A112: God's will is that we never give false testimony against anyone, twist no one's words, not gossip or slander, nor join in condemning anyone without a hearing or just cause. We should avoid lying and deceit of every kind. We should love the truth, speak it candidly, and openly acknowledge it.
