

Returning to Worship on June 14

Please read and familiarize yourself with these guidelines **before returning** to worship.

1. Use common sense and practice social distancing. If you are experiencing any COVID-like symptoms or have serious underlying conditions, please wait to return to worship.
2. Masks are encouraged but not required. The church will be providing masks if you choose to wear one.
3. If you are a nursery volunteer, you must wear a mask while on duty. The nursery coordinator and children are not required to wear masks.
4. Sunday Morning Fellowship will return at its regular time (9:15 in Decker Hall). Please limit **2 persons per table**, unless in the same household.

Sanctuary Guidelines for 10:30 Worship

1. No congregating or greeting within the foyer. Please visit while using social distancing in the parking lot.
2. Households/families are encouraged to sit together on the same pew. If not in the same household, limit seating to **4 persons per pew**. Please leave one empty pew in between.
3. No offering plate will be passed during the service, but it will be placed at the back of the sanctuary at the end of worship.
4. If you are not comfortable using the provided hymnals and Bibles, please bring your own Bible. All the hymns are viewable online at hymnary.org (Revised Trinity Hymnal).
5. **Communion and Easter Sunday will not be celebrated until August.**
6. Services will still be recorded and available on Facebook Live and our website. If you are having issues watching the live video, the audio will be uploaded to the website Sunday evening or the video can be downloaded from Facebook after the live broadcast is complete.
7. Be sure to use our **NEW ENTRANCE** when driving into the parking lot. The old entrance will serve as the permanent exit.
