Scripture Reading: Jude 7-9

- In **verses 5-7**, there are three **punishments** for following false teaching:
 - You'll be destroyed
 - You'll be in eternal chains
 - You'll eternally burn

First Point = You'll eternally burn Verse 7

- Reference to the destruction of <u>Sodom and Gomorrah</u> in **Genesis 19**.
 - o *"indulged in sexual immorality and pursued unnatural desire"*
 - Homosexuality
 - 1 Corinthians 6:9, Romans 1:18-25
 - The **punishment** for this lifestyle, and *any unrepentant sin*, is: "a punishment of eternal fire"
 - Hell
 - Revelation 20:10

Second Point = Seek the truth Verses 8 & 9

- In **verses 8-10**, Jude jumps from using Old Testament examples of the past to **CONNECT** the present by telling us what these false teachers were doing. <u>Verse 8 is our answer</u>.
 - *"relying on their dreams"* they do **three** things:
 - Defile flesh
 - Reject authority

 Blaspheme the glorious ones

- Being called a *"dreamer"* was a derogatory term
 - **EX:** Genesis 37:19, Deuteronomy 13:1-3
- The examples of **verses 5-7** are summarized in **verse 8**!

VERSE 9: Perhaps, the most complicated/confusing verse of Jude. *Three things to see about this verse:*

- The Bible does reveal various classes of angels.
 - **Angels** the general term for God's messengers & heavenly servants.
 - **Cherubim** serve as guardians (Genesis 3:24, Exodus 25:18, Psalm 80:1)
 - **Seraphim** mentioned only once in Scripture in Isaiah 6, meaning *"burning ones"*.
 - **Gabriel** 1 of 2 angels named in Scripture, his name meaning, *"God is my strength"* (Daniel 8-9, Luke 1, Revelation 8?).
 - Michael the other angel named in Scripture, his name meaning, "Who is like God?" (Daniel 10, 12; Jude 9, Revelation 12). He's the only one given the title, "archangel" meaning "chief angel". We only see this term in one other place: 1 Thessalonians 4:16. Also described as "your prince" in Daniel 10:21.
 - **Angel of the Lord/LORD** = depending on the CONTEXT, could be Jesus in pre-incarnate, theophanic form OR a regular angel & messenger of God.
- <u>The Devil wants Moses' body?</u>
 - This is the **ONLY** place in Scripture this event is mentioned.
 - Speculation of Deuteronomy 34
 - Where does it say in Scripture that angels guard corpses?
 - What would Satan do with the body of Moses anyway?
 - **(CORRECT)** this verse refers to a man-made, extra-biblical document known as *"The Assumption of Moses"*.
 - A common document everyone knew was false, yet we, close to 2,000 years later aren't so familiar with it.
- Michael doesn't behave like a false teacher would
 - Zechariah 3, Acts 17, Titus 1.
 - If Michael DID say this at the end of verse 9, it's the exact **opposite** of what the false teachers are doing from verse 4 & 8.
- Jude warns us to SEEK THE TRUTH!
 - John 17:16-17
