Scripture Reading: Judges 6:1-24

We meet our fifth judge: GIDEON


Besides Samson, Gideon is the second judge we have the most information about: Judges 6-8

1. God sends a prophet (verses 1-10)

God's sending of judges to Israel repeatedly followed a fourfold cycle:

- 1. <u>Apostasy</u>: the Israelites do what is evil in the sight of the Lord
- 2. <u>Servitude</u>: God allows the nation to be conquered & oppressed
- 3. <u>Supplication</u>: the people cry out to God
- 4. <u>Salvation</u>: God sends a judge to deliver the Israelites

The cycle *repeats* after the current judge dies



- The **Midianites** oppress the Israelites in 4 ways:
 - They force them to live in caves
 - They devour all their crops

- We learn from verse 3 that they're not alone: The Amalekites & the *"people of the East"* are also helping
 - Significance & discussion of the phrase "people of the east"/ "East"
- They consume & abuse all their livestock
- They pollute the land
- Instead of a judge, first they receive a **prophet**. He reminds them of *two things*:
 - What **God** has done
 - What **they** have done
 - Regret vs. repentance

2. God sends a sign (verses 11-24)

- God sends a heavenly visitor in verse 11
 - WHO is it though?
- We meet Gideon in hiding
- "How can I save Israel?"
- **Two** things to take home with us tonight:
 - *May we never disregard the Bible* = <u>2 Timothy 3:16-17, Joshua 1:8</u>
 - \circ God never hesitates to apply his holiness & grace = <u>Romans 5:8</u>
